A. National scheme for the reduction of parental payment

Households shall not pay more than six percent of their income for their child to attend kindergarten. This scheme applies to households with a total income of less than NOK 548 500 per year (as of 01.08.2019).

The scheme is regulated in the ordinance on parental payment in kindergartens. The aim is to facilitate more children having the opportunity to attend kindergarten through lower prices for families with low income.

B. Free core time

All 2, 3, 4 and 5 year olds, and children with postponed school start, living in low income households, are entitled to 20 hours of free stay in kindergarten per week. This scheme applies to families or households with a total annual income of less than NOK 548 500 (as of 01.08.2019)

In Haugesund municipality, the scheme is managed by the Service Centre.

C. Income to be considered

Kindergarten fee shall be calculated on the basis of the household's total taxable capital and personal income:

Personal income:

- ✓ Gross earned income
- ✓ Income from sole proprietorship or business
- ✓ Social security benefits (*log on to "my page", nav.no*); sickness benefits, disability benefits, work assessments allowance, transitional benefits, introductory benefits etc.

Capital investment income:

- ✓ Interest earnings and share dividends
- ✓ Earnings from sale and real estate and movable property
- ✓ Rental income
- ✓ Rights of use of capital and gratuitous use of assets of others

D. Documentation that must be submitted with the application

The latest tax return shall be enclosed with the application as documentation. If some taxable personal or capital income is not registered on the tax return, the applicant is obligated to provide information on this when applying.

As a rule, the application must be for a year of kindergarten at a time.

E. If the applicant does not have tax returns

Should someone not be able to submit tax returns, due to short-term residence in the country, for example, applicants may submit other documentation for taxable income $-\frac{\text{refer to point C.}}{\text{Documentation from te past 3 months most be provided by the applicant.}}$

F. If the income has changed from the previous year

Applicants may submit other documentation for income, or apply during the year if there is a substantial and lasting change in income for the household. Significant and lasting change in income means significant loss of income due to long-term unemployment, change in household composition or similar issues. Applications are processed continuously.
